
we are getting lots of enquiries regarding Membership of BMISS, UKTD and the IBFF. Membership is automatic for any Fauna of a Soft Cuddly Toy Persuasion. Humes cannot be members unless they have survived a Descent of 3,000 ft(1,000 mts) minimum sans a Parachute, Humes can of coursebe Dropniks, Assistants, Crew, etc, etc, though it should be understood that whtever a hume decides to be, He or she, will always play second Fiddle to a Full Member.

Another question which crops up with amazing regularity is the one about "To Stuff, or not to Stuff the Jolly Old Rag". Whilst we have no serious objections to an Unstuffed Rag, we feel that any Fauna making Descents with an already Deployed Chute, is not entering into the Spirit of the Game. Most of the excitement obtained from Parachuting Fauna is from the uncertainty of whether or not the Chute will open upon release. Some of our Members who descend on Unstuffed Rags, complain that after a while is all very Tame. So dear Members, if its excitement you want, you must encourage your Dropnik to GET STUFFED.....

At the risk of Boring the Pants off our Old Hand Members and Dropniks, on P.2 we shall provide a "BACK to BASICS" Feature. Flease bear with us as we try to impart some Information to those who are new to the Parachuting of F.S.C.T Variety.

Parachuting Easy O.K. Those readers of R.C. who at the present do not engage in the True Lunatic Fringe of International Kiting, i.e. Parachuting of Fauna, should be advised that pretty well the First Item they require is a Fauna of the Soft Cuddly Toy Variety. Secondly, unless they intend to be what EMISS terms A Right B% &£ & &d, Dropnik, i.e., one who drops Fauna with no Parachute at all, potential Dropniks will a Parachute find, very Handy. The following sketches will give you a start. The Cardboard Cutout uses Unproofed or Loomstate Riprtop for his Chutes. If this type of Ripstop is not available locally, then use the Lightest Material you can find.

A TEMPLATE for the Chute Gores or Panelscan be cut from thin card. The sides of the Template should be Curved, via a F/Glass Rod, otherwise the Canopy will be Distorted. 14 off, will give a Chute of approx 1 Metre Dia. The Shroud Lines are also



with loop through eyelets and secure with Static Line Pin.

Fauna Harness size obviously varies with size of Fauna.

It is easily made from Ripstop. The shoulder Risers, suspension Strap and Fack are Sewm to the Harness. Easiest way to attach Fauna to Kite Line is via a Pipe Cleaner, one end of which is attached firmly to the Kite Line. The free end is passed through the Fauna's Suspension Strap D. Ring and then loosley looped over the Kite Line. With static line also attached firmly to the Kite Line, the deley before the Fipe cleaner lets go is enough to let you longlaunch a Fauna.
