




otherwise known as Paul (my Kites reach parts other Lagers cannot (we had to get the plug in somewhere) touch ) Morgan Tah Dahh ....



5 off 25cm Ripstop Squares plus 2 cut diagonally .....



sew together as above times four .....



Then bung 'em all together so you end up with like this (hope we have 'nt lost you so far)

(something should go between like and with, Hmm I wonder)

Then you Seam all around the edges joining all the parts together till you end up with something that looks vaguely like this. If it dont, its best to chuck it in the Bin and start again, after all, whats time and some Ripstop scraps to a

Dropnik of your Demeanor. Thats right, hang the expense, throw the

Cat another Kipper.

Right where was we before we got sidetracked ? oh yeah if you do have something that looks like this, then its time to Nail on some Shroud Lines from the points marked \* The Shrouds should be about 3ft or a Metre long and are connected to a swivel,

For best results a Ball Bearing Swivel is best, these can be found at any Fishing Tackle Shop at reasonable cost. With the sizes given, the Chute will only be suitable for a smallish Fauna, but it should be fairly easy to Scale Up, so experiment.

We reckon you've sussed out that on descent, the Fauna Faces the same way all the time, whilst the Chute revolves above him or her. So Dropniks, if you are into Gas Pipe Fitting, or are Counter Revolutionary, or just naturaly of a Left Hand Threaded Persuasion, just turn the Chute inside out and it'll go the other way. Hello Sailor.

Lots of Dropniks out there, have made or are in the process of making thier own version of the Fauna Ferry shown in the last issue. The BOF's one has now nearly completed a whole Season of use and has performed really well, given a suitable Wind.

The Ferry was put on to a diet and now weighs in at just a Pound (say 450 grams) part of the diet was the reuse of Dowel Wingspreaders (4".6mm) These, probably due to the Spring loaded Line Stop, seem to be able to take the strain. So we now have two sets of spreaders, one in F/glass for strong winds and one in Dowel for lighter winds.

Funnily enough, when the BOF weighed all the parts of the Ferry separately, the two

Ripstop Sails weighed the most.

Re the photo on page one. We've since heard from Dropnik Don that the Stafford Castle Bash went off very well. In fact so many Fauna were dropped for the Kids, that Don and the Crew ended up well Knackered. But there again is'nt that what its all about?
