A worthwhile addition to any Canopy is a Pilot Chute, which can be made to perform exactly the same as the Pilot on a full size 'HUME' Parachute. Easily constructed, the Pilot is actually a small Chute in its own right, which helps to deploy the main Canopy. Consisting of Six or Eight Gores, the Pilot is attached to the main Chute via a length of Tape, Ripstop or whatever else takes your fancy. The static line is then fed into the crown of the pilot which in its is folded and stowed neatly with all excess connector into the tube.

Upon releasing the Bear, the Static line pulls the pilot chute from its tube, deploys it and in doing so, the pilot chute pulls the pin on the chute pack and deploys the main.

Brother Gaylord sent a cutting which referred to the Thanksgiving Day Custom of throwing live Tukeys from a Plane, this by the way is in the Ozark Region of the U.S. Unfortunately many of these birds cannot fly and this coupled with the lack of Chutes, end in some rather serious 'TOTALS'.
